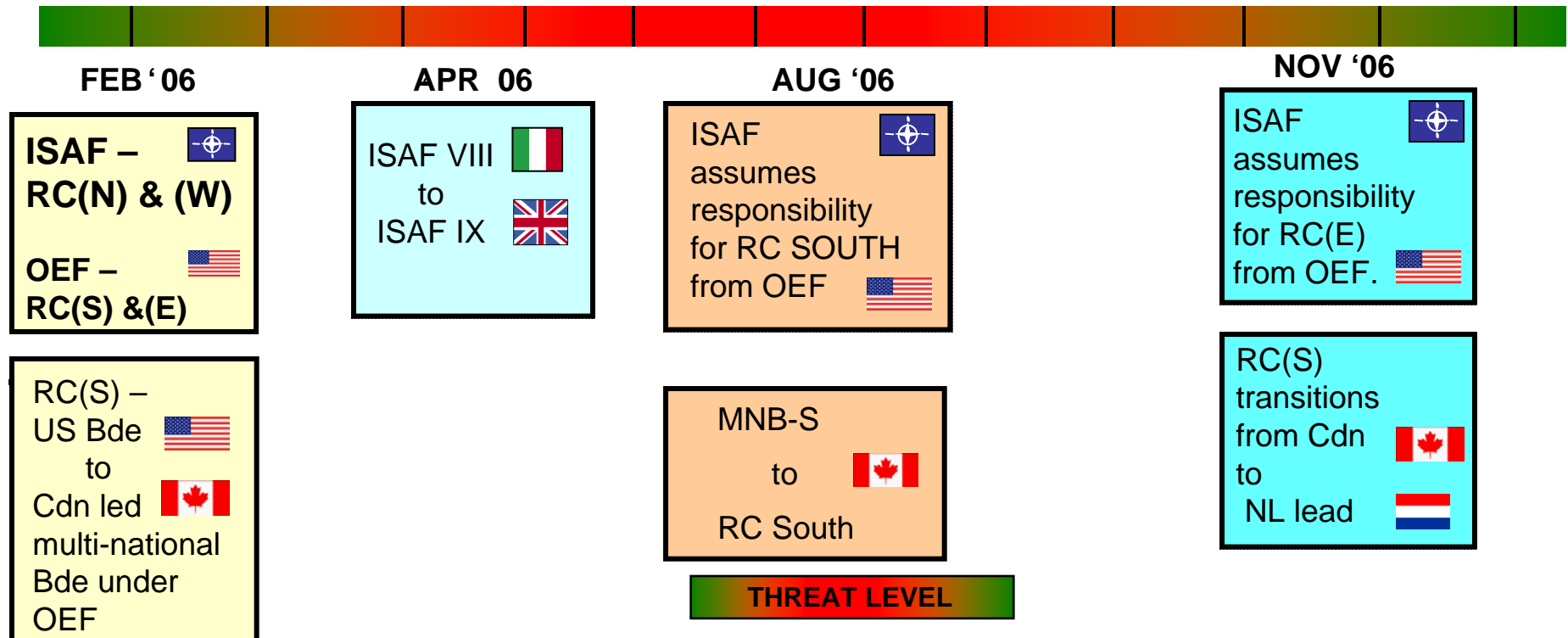
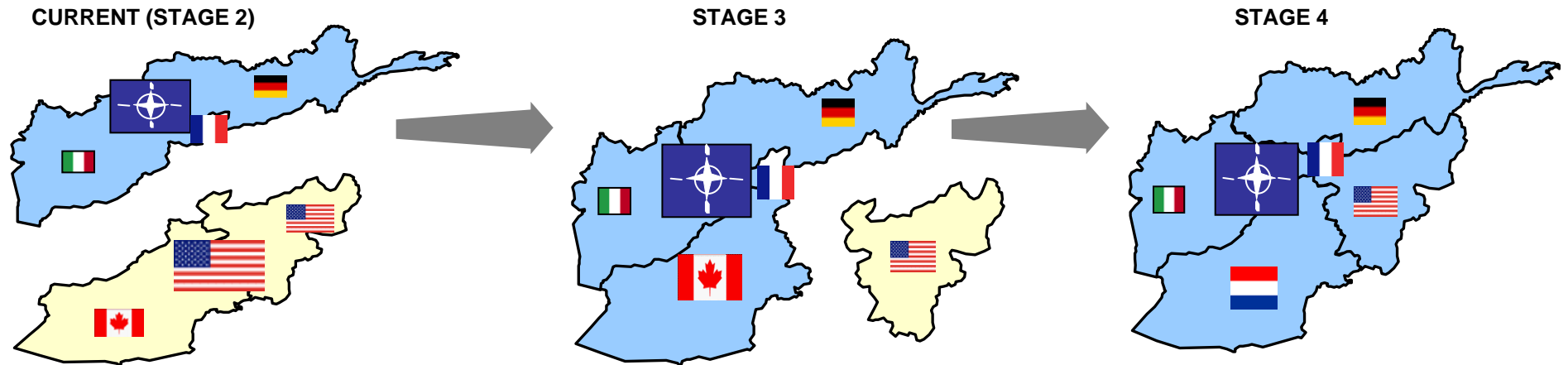




# Canada's Intent for PRT

  - Tribal affiliations
  - Geography
    - Agriculture
    - Herding
    - Urban
  - Threat
  - Accessibility

**Sub-Zones will assist in focusing limited troops and resources while maximizing effect on CoG**

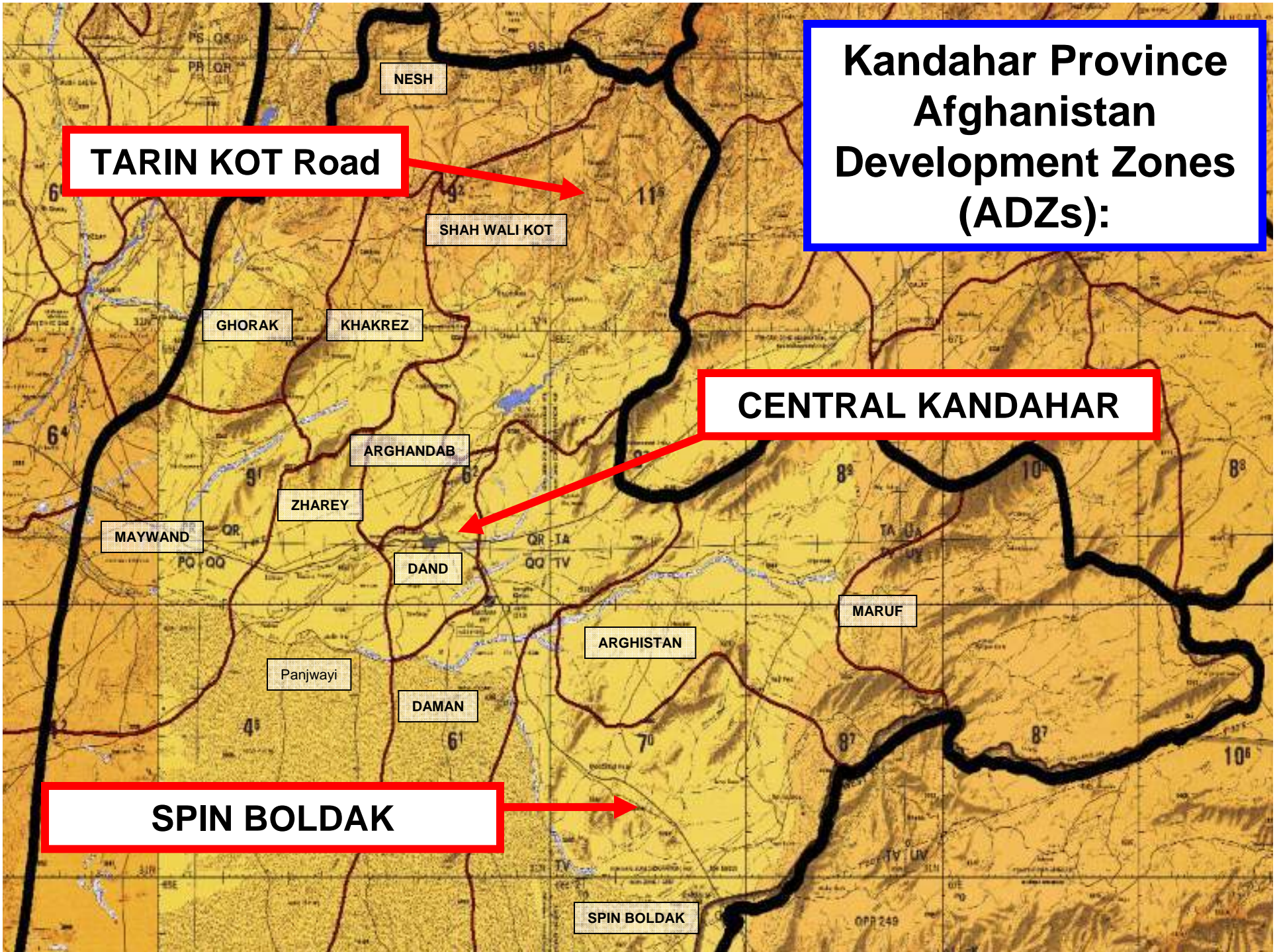

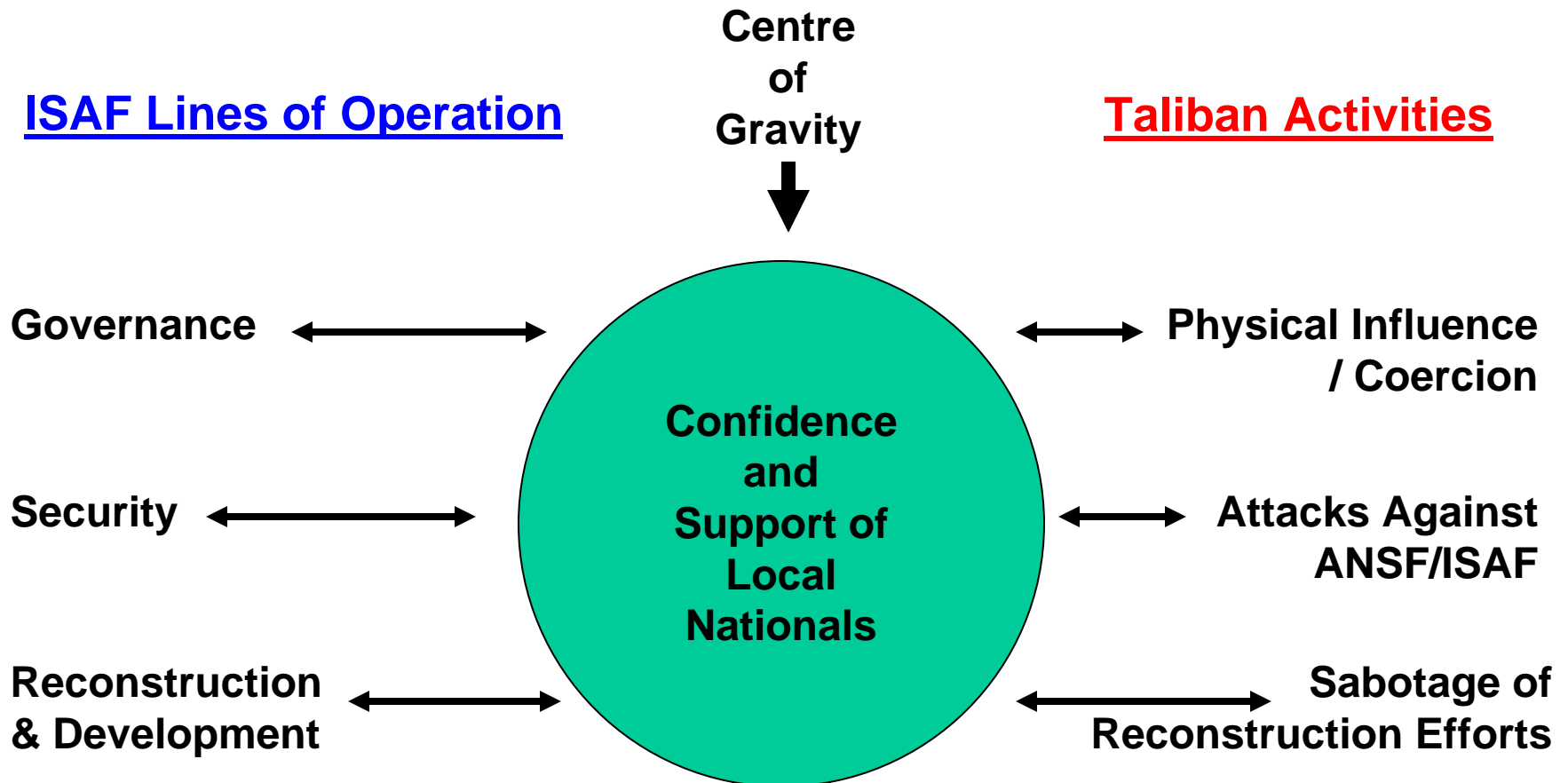

# Kandahar Centre of Gravity



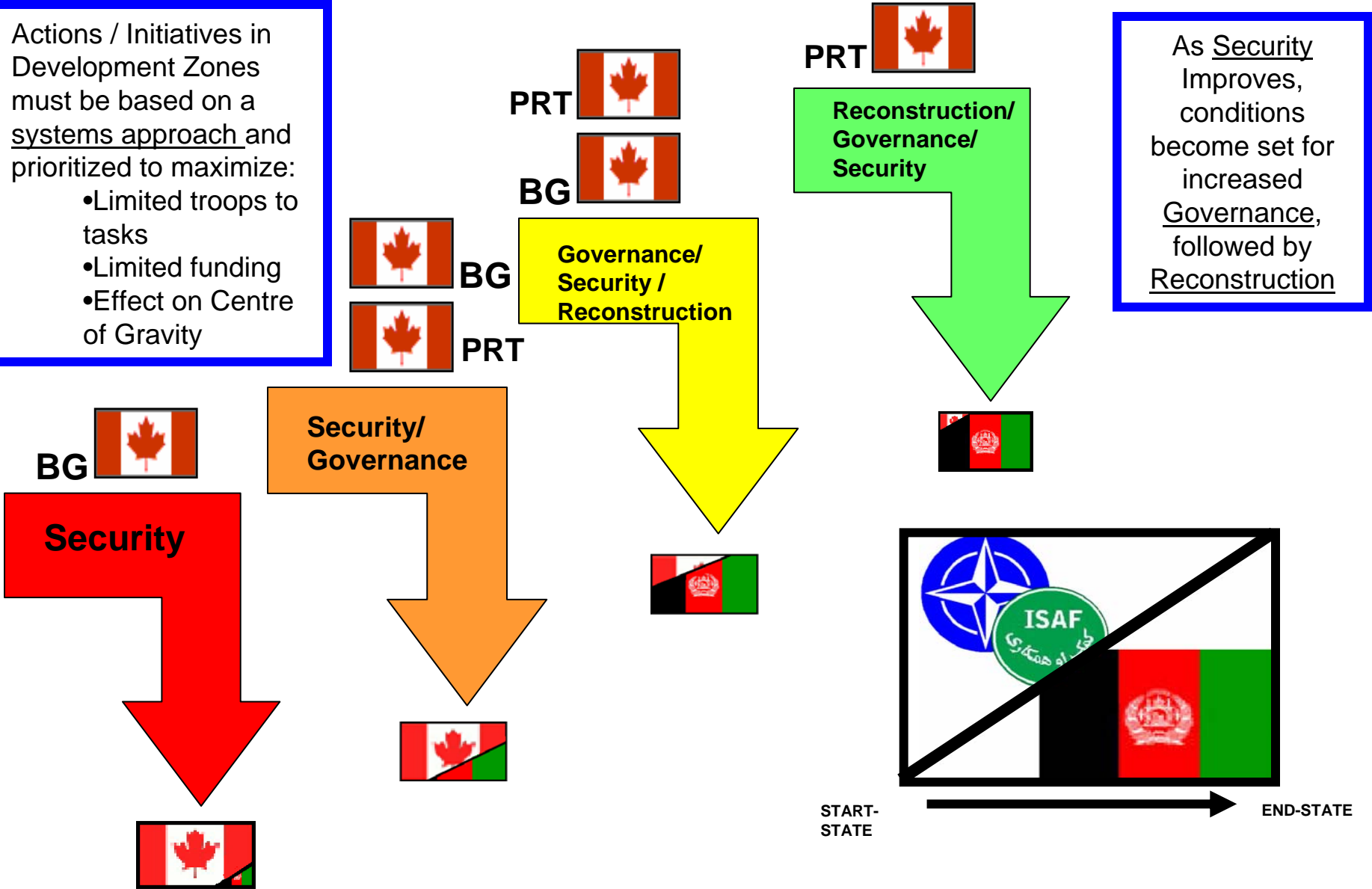
# Systems Approach to ADZs

- Limited troops to tasks
- Limited funding
- Effect on Centre of Gravity

# Governance Systems



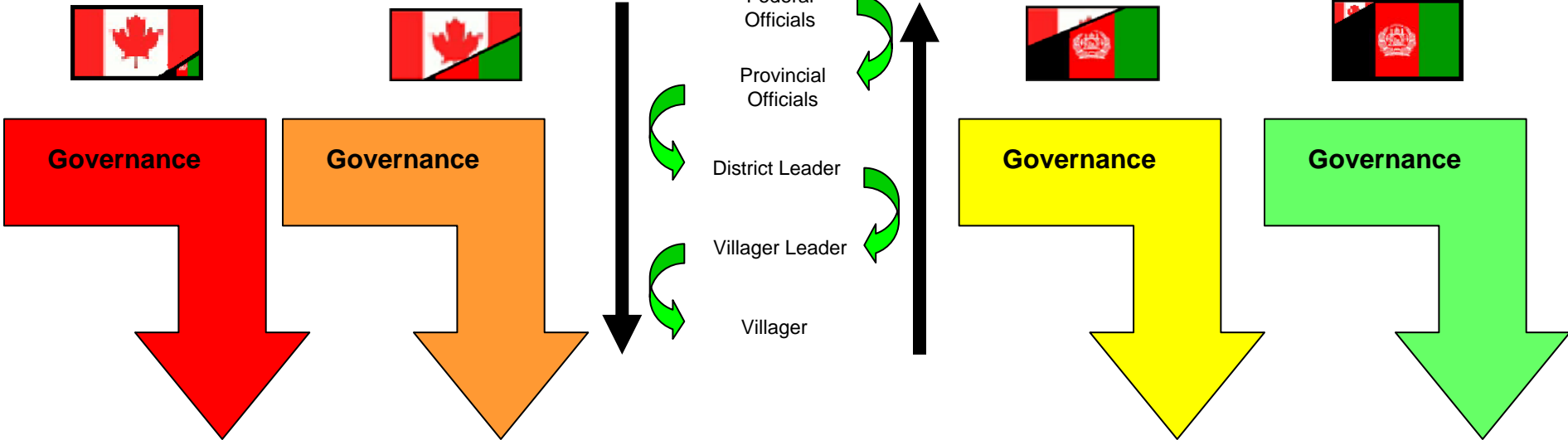
## CRITERIA

- NGOs operating when protected by private security companies
- District economy
- Infrastructure requires some repair
- Some legitimate agricultural activity

- NGOs Operating freely
- Integrated economy
- Well developed Infrastructure
- Strong legitimate agricultural activity
